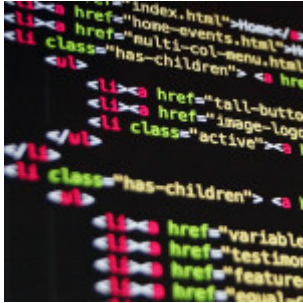


## Common
