

AT&T Overcharged Washington, DC, for 5 Years, Must Pay \$1.5M

“AT&T overcharged the District of Columbia government for more than five years and has ‘agreed to pay \$1.5 million for its failure to comply with its long-term contract with the District for cell phone and Internet services,’ ... The settlement doesn’t recoup the full amount of overcharges alleged by Washington, DC, which says AT&T ‘overcharg[ed] District taxpayers by millions of dollars,’” reports Jon Brodtkin in *ARS Technica*.

“AT&T did not admit to any wrongdoing in the settlement.”
