The mission of the Maryland State Board of Elections is to ensure compliance with the requirements of Maryland and federal election laws by all persons involved in the process. The board is made up of five members who serve four-year terms and represent both principal political parties – three of the majority and two of the minority party. The members are appointed by the governor, with the advice and consent of the Maryland Senate.
