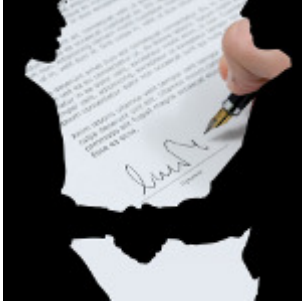


Real Estate Development and Construction Contracts: What You Need to Know
