

Sullivan Recruits Angela Gomes From Skadden as Partner in Boston Office

During law school, she served as both vice president and then president of the Black Law Students Association. She also was articles editor of the Journal of Science and Technology Law. Acknowledging her service, in 2010 Boston University School of Law Black Law Students Association awarded Gomes its "Young Alumni Award," and in 2018 they awarded her with the "Trailblazer" award. In 2014, Boston University School of Law presented her with its "Alumni Pro Bono Award." Angela was also a Leadership Council on Legal Diversity Fellow.
