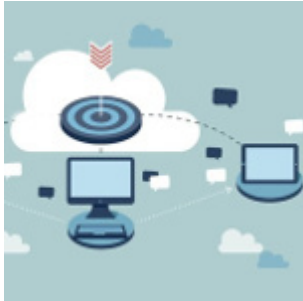


Key Considerations When Contracting Cloud
