In-House Counsel See Increase in Income



The 2019 In-House Counsel Compensation Report published by BarkerGilmore reveals that inhouse counsel saw their income increase by an average of 4.4 percent.

The survey compares income from 2017 to 2018.

As in past years, women in-house counsel made less than their male counterparts — collecting just 85 percent as much on average.

Male general counsel in the study made an average of \$630,000, compared to \$537,000 for women GCs.
