GAO: Performance-Based Contracts Are the Way to Go



Performance-based contracting received a boost this month when the Government Accountability Office found that the U.S. Department of Transportation is making progress in moving toward a national performance-based approach, reports *Forbes*.

In Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century (MAP-21), the DOT recognized the importance of a more progressive approach in the way federal agencies and states do business with each other, with planning organizations and with private vendors.

According to the *Forbes* report, in the fiscal year 2013, DOT provided about \$50 billion to states and other "grantees" — such as metropolitan planning organizations and transit agencies — to support highway and transit infrastructure and safety.
