

The Top 10 Questions Facing the LNG Industry in 2016



Although continuing low oil prices affect the LNG industry in expected ways (e.g. delays and cancellations in the development of LNG export projects) and unexpected ways (e.g. take-overs between major players in an already consolidated industry), a prolonged LNG oversupply notwithstanding tapering Asian demand could be the most widespread industry impact in 2016, write **Philip Weems** and **Monica Hwang** in an article on **King & Spalding's** Energy Law Exchange.
