

Seaman's Attempted \$64 Million Settlement of Badlands Litigation Implodes

"Las Vegas City Councilwoman Victoria Seaman must be crestfallen. Her best efforts to hand a local developer and political benefactor a bale of money to call off the dogs of litigation over the fate of the former Badlands Golf Course busted out just a day before delivery. Seaman didn't exactly," reports John L. Smith in The Nevada Independent.

"In the name of fiscal responsibility, she had what she described as a negotiation with EHB Companies to dismiss with prejudice a series of lawsuits, one of which has gone against the city and is on appeal at the Nevada Supreme Court, in exchange for a package worth at least \$64 million.
